WINTER LEAGUE 2010

Winter League 2010 will begin on Saturday, January 2nd at 10:00 am. The league will consist of 300 birds (12 rounds). There will not be a bye week this year. Please be sure to look at the posted dates for each week, as there are some changes this year. League will end on Saturday, April 3rd at 6:00 pm. Sign up sheets are posted on the bulletin board. Cost for the leagues will be as follows for Trap & Skeet: Charter \$65 and Associate \$71 per event. There will not be a Sporting Clays league this year. Teams for Trap & Skeet are 5 person. We will be throwing the green targets for league this year.

You must purchase your punch card for each event that you will be shooting before you shoot your first registered round. You may sign up for league any time before January 31st. You must have 4 registered lines in by January 31st. They can be shot all in one day with no penalty. Beginning February 3rd, normal Winter League rules will be in effect. Also you must have your membership dues paid by January 31st. Copies of Winter League rules will be available at the front counter, it is advised that everyone take time to read over them so there are no misunderstandings. Once again, be sure to look at the week-by-week schedule that is posted, so you know what week we are on so as to avoid penalties.

Banquet will be held on Saturday, April 17th and Calcutta on Sunday, April 18th. Shooting Committee members for 2010 will be posted on the board by the beginning of league.

Reminder that you must be club member to participate in any league. We will be offering the Trial 4-month membership to persons who have never been a member of the club before. If you think you may know of someone who may be interested in shooting, bring them out and have them sign up for the Trial membership.

TRIAL MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

This membership is available for purchase only thru the end January. It will be good for the following dates: January 2nd thru April 30th. This will cover the length of league, banquet and calcutta. This is a one time only trial and is only for someone who has never been a club member before. Hence anyone who used this program last year or the previous years that it was offered, may not repeat. Trial members dues will be \$35 and are payable at the time of registration for any league. At the conclusion of league, the Trial member will have until April 30th to join the club as an associate. The \$35 will be credited towards the 2010 dues. The purpose of this membership is to try to introduce a new person to the club by letting them shoot in one of our leagues on the Trial membership. Then at the end of league, if they enjoyed the club facilities we hope that they will consider joining the club as an associate member for the rest of the year. Please note that this Trial membership is only to be sold to persons that are going to participate in a league. It is not available to any other persons or someone who has been a member before.

ARCHERY LEAGUE NEWS

The indoor winter archery leagues are scheduled as follows, and run 12 weeks with a banquet and awards in late March:

For traditional gear shooters, league scoring starts Tuesday, January 5th. Be at the club with your bow before 7:00 pm.

Compound bow shooters should be at the club before 7:00 pm on Thursday, January 7th for registration (or stop by Wednesday if you like). This first night is for some shooting for fun or make up rounds, a rules review and team pairings. Scoring rounds start the following week, there may be both Wednesday and Thursday shooting provided there are enough interest to make it viable. There is a youth backstop at half the distance of adult shooters (just 10 yards) making more fun for them to participate in the league.

Judging for the archery big buck contest will be on Sunday, January 3rd at 2:00 pm.
