**Salmon in the Classroom** is a hands on science activity run by a participating school system in conjunction with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. By supplying a small brood of fertilized eggs to a classroom teacher, as well as a one day training seminar, the DNR provides a select group of science teachers the opportunity to provide their students with the rewarding prospect of working with "live" resources. The students are able to participate in a very interactive program in which they raise the resource, and are ultimately responsible for it's survival and release.
