## SUMMER LEAGUE

### All Games Shotgun League

This is a fun league of 3 person teams with 200 birds scored. It consists of 2 trap rounds, 2 wobble trap rounds, 2 skeet rounds and 50 birds of sporting clays (this can be optionally shot as 2 rounds of 25).

If you have a single shot firearm (or simply prefer it), the doubles on skeet and sporting clays can be shot as singles.

It started May 15th and ends August 15th. Sign up anytime - you can shoot it all on the last day if you want. There is no formal shooting schedule to follow. Cost is \$35 for charter members and \$40 for associate members.

Last year we had over 30 participants. It's a lot of fun and variety of shooting. Come out and test your skills on all of the ranges.

A 3-month trial membership is available for \$25 to brand new members who's like to participate in the league. Late registration is permitted but you must submit 3 scores by August 1st to enable timely handicapping and publishing of scores.
